SUBJECT: Skagit River, Washington - Levee and Channel Improvements

1. On 20 January 1977, Mr. Bud Norris, a newly elected Skagit County Commissioner (phone: 206-336-3287), called me concerning the Skagit River Levee and Channel Improvements project.
2. Commissioner Norris noted that flood control for the Skagit River is one of his primary interests, and I briefly reviewed with him the history of subject study and its current status.
3. The next time I am in Mt. Vernon, Commissioner Norris offered to show me several areas on Fir Island for which he has some ideas regarding flood protection. He would also like to discuss his thoughts for setting up a meeting (sometime this spring) with groups affected by the proposed levee and channel improvements. I advised Commissioner Norris that by mid-March I hope to complete initial paperwork (plan of study) upon which the upcoming study effort will be based. With the concurrence of Commissioner Norris, we agreed to get together some time in latter March. Details will be arranged later.
