- 2. The purpose of the visit was to introduce the new Skagit County Engineer, Gene Sampley, to the District Engineer and to bring him up to date on the project. The briefing covered the history of water resources development in the lower Skagit basin including Upper Baker Dam, the Avon Bypass and the presently authorized Levee and Channel Improvement Project. The sequence of steps leading to the construction of the project was also covered as it relates to the proposed legislation to extend the authorized project. Specific project details which were then covered included alternative levee alinements; alternatives for protection of the Mt.
