SUBJECT: Skagit River Levee and Channel Improvements - Meeting with Skagit County

1. On 3 November 1978 I met with Messrs Sampley, Nelson and Skrinde of Skagit County to discuss the progress of our studies. Mr. Sampley and Mr. Nelson said that what little reaction they had received since the 1 November 1978 meeting of the Skapit Flood Control Council was favorable. We discussed the project in general and Larry Scudder of Civil Design Section had asked for a clarification on the requirement for a road slope away from the levee in relocated sections. Mr. Sampley said that it was essential to maintain a superelevation on curves so the road at those locations could slope toward the levee and a small ditch and culvert installed to drain water. Mr. Melson asked for the identification of the roads to be relocated. We will provide this information as well as data on other required relocations as soon as possible.

2. Mr. Sampley also was interested in whether Corps help could be obtained for a bank erosion problem along Dead Man's Slough next to the South Skagit Highway about 4 miles east of Sedro Woolley. Mr. Simon Yang of Civil Design Section explained our Section 14 program and asked that the county write a letter to the District Engineers outlining the problem and requesting our help. Mr. Sampley said the county would submit such a letter in the near future.
