Dear Senator Magnuson:

During our recent trip to Washington, D. C., we had a discussion with your staff, headed by Mike Stewart, regarding the Sauk River. We are asking you, at this time, to request the Public Works Committee to make a study of the Sauk River, a tributary of the Skagit River, with regard to the feasibility of a flood control dam.

This dam would be for flood control only during the flood stage period and the Sauk would be a free-flowing stream during the other seasons of the year.

With the increased growth and valuation of the Skagit Valley, we must extend our control during flood periods from our eight (8) year protection which we presently have, to at least fifty (50) year protection. We believe that this study on the Sauk would determine the feasibility of such a dam as, during flood seasons, the Sauk can carry 40% of the water that empties into the Skagit River.

Your help and cooperation will be deeply appreciated by the Board of Skagit County Commissioners and the people of Skazit County.
