- **A. PL12-0438, Modification to Shoreline Substantial Development Permit PL08-0144.** Douglas and Linda MacGregor propose to modify the existing Shoreline Substantial Development Permit PL08-0144 to allow for the installation and use of utilities including water and electrical power to operate a winch and light the dock. Power will be utilized to operate six lights on the dock and for operation of a mechanical winch which will be used to lift the floating portion of the dock out of the water. The water utility is intended as a water supply for **operation of the applicant's r**ecreational boat and for dock maintenance. The subject site is located at 4132 Point Williams Place on Samish Island. The parcel is located within the NE quarter of Section 28, Township 36 N, Range 2 E, W.M., Skagit County, WA. - **B. Shoreline Substantial Development Permit PL12-0144.** This project is an eastern extension of the levee maintenance project initiated by the City of Burlington, and Skagit County Dike, Drainage and Irrigation District No. 12, intended to increase flood protections for the City of Burlington. Skagit County Dike, Drainage and Irrigation District No. 12 propose to enlarge both the width and the height of the existing Skagit River levee along the 1.53 mile long project site. The elevation at the top of the levee will be increased by approximately 4 feet in height and the toe or base of the levee will be increased by approximately 60 feet in width. The widening of the dike will be limited to an area landward of the existing levee toe. The project extends from the Burlington City limits at Gardner Road north to the terminus of the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad on Lafayette Road in the North within Section 4, Township 34 North, Range 4 East & Section 33, Township 35 North, Range 4 East, W.M., Skagit County, WA.
