DINES HAVE BEEN RELOCATED THREE TIMES

- 1881 . . Private dikes established as the first river propection. Located a distance of from 5 to 6 miles west of the Bkagin River in Sections 8, 17, 20, 29, 32, Twp. 34, E5. Not successful because some property owners refused to pay their anare of the one
- 1895 . . . State law for the first time permitted of the side ing districts. Dike District 12 was built along the Bragit River beginning at Wiles Slough July south west side of the river, to Eurlington, through Bestions &. 5, Twp. 34, R5, following the high ground to connect with the Great Northern Hallroad SE of Burlington on section 33. Twp. 35, R4; thence following the railroad grade to starling Dam.
- . A new section of the dike in the immediate vicinity of southeast Burlington was relocated. In order to give the property north and east of this new area protoction, it is going to be necessary to go on up the river to Sedro Woolley and Minkler Lake. The dike has been raised an overall height of 2 feet for a distance of approximately 9 miles. As they continue to build restrictions into the river below us, narrowing the stream flow, it will be necessary to raise the height of the dike.
- 1961 . . . Vast sewer systems installed along the river in recent years need protection not now available. New Highway 99 will hold water in a pocket. The board is of the opinion that the local people would be willing to contribute dollars toward a feasible project to eliminate any danger from flood.
